The two main CLI clients irssi and WeeChat both use the current way of using /away (without message) for coming back. It's also specified similarly in the RFC.

GUI clients tend to have something like /back, but tbh, if you have a GUI, you can provide a much nicer way such as using a toolbar button anyway. A /back command could be added by way of an alias/plugin later.

Therefore, we have decided to keep it like it is no.
