**Description**

I have been noticing this behaviour for a while now but it still seems present in 0.13-rc1. However, in earlier versions, the system tray icon would disappear until a client restart. In 0.13-rc1, it doesn't disappear at all.

Version: v0.13-rc1 (git-60dde7fa)  
OS: Windows 10 1803

Steps to reproduce:  
Unselect the checkbox Settings -> Interface -> Show system tray icon

Expected behaviour:  
The system tray icon disappears

Actual behaviour:  
The system tray icon remains unchanged
