<p>With the current Kubuntu package, we default to freednode (called Kubuntu IRC) and #kubuntu. Traffic for #kubuntu also shows up in the network buffer too. It looks almost like they are symlinked as if I click on one, they both unhighlight for no pending traffic. Also it doesn't matter if I move where it is on the list.</p> <p>I only see this in the mono client, but my buffer list in the split client predates the package provided list.</p> <p>I'm not sure if this is my patch or some other issue. Patch attached.</p>
