#### Description

I think it would be a great idea to be able to assign a hotkey to a buffer/discussion/thread/whatever that allows you to quickly select it.

Hotkeys would be assigned by right-clicking the buffer and clicking a set-hotkey menu option, a dialog box should then appear that waits for the user to input a key combination to use as a hotkey.

Each buffer's hotkey should be displayed next to the buffer name in the list, optionally.

Clearing the hotkey would be done while right-clicking the buffer and selecting a menu option, clear hotkey.
