| <p>If you join channel (let's say #ubuntu-release-party) which was later closed and forwarded to #ubuntu, the core will still try connecting to #ubuntu-release-party; (which looks like a good behaviour) but...</p> <p>It will even happend to it, if you leave #ubuntu (not #ubuntu-release-party which can't be joined) before restarting the core.</p> <p>Looks like if the channel is forwarded and we leave from the 'forwarded channe' the core should also mark the 'first channel, which forwarded us' like a 'not connect at start';</p> <p>Currently you can change the behaviour from the sqlite3; sqlite3 ~/.config/quassel-irc.org/quassel-storage.sqlite update buffer set joined=0 where buffername="#ubuntu-release-party";</p> | | | |
